Position being advertised and we have appointed Yvonne White. It will be called Ms White's classroom. In September, Claire Kelly was appointed when interviews were held. She started today. If a child who is in 1st class enrols, SNA hours will be increased. This will be most likely be given to Leanne Byrne. Grants have been given for the special class. Cost to the school has been nothing. Grant has been given to sensory room. LoG to visit sensory room specialist place on Thursday. Plugs to be raised up. Children have to have diagnosis to be in this class. Rev Canon Craig thanked LoG and staff for their patience and understanding with various behaviours of concern which arise. LoG wants to get to know the children before purchasing any more resources. It is important to ensure the correct resources are bought.

8. **Principal Report**

Enrolment

All Junior classes are full. There is one position available in each class $3rd - 6^{th}$. 1 pupil has left 3rd class and 1 pupil has left 4th class. Due to the exceptional needs in both of these classes, it is requested of the BoM that these positions are not filled with new pupils. BOM agreed with this.

St David's was sanctioned a special class on the 21.9.23. Grants have been applied for and received on the 2.10.23. Enrolment enquires have come in. On 4.10.23 we were confirmed our first pupil for the class. We can take up to 6 pupils with specific autism reports where the report specifically states the pupil requires a special class setting. These places must be sanctioned by the SENO.
